When you do not follow these instructions, delays are inevitable in your examination registration, and you might NOT be registered. The staff at IPMZ do their best to understand your registration requirements, but sometimes you make their task more difficult than necessary! SO...

1. We have a number of departments dealing with different matters so, when writing to the Institute, please write a separate letter for each request. You can put your separate request into one envelope. This is especially important when making examination registration requests.

REMEMBER – YOUR NAME AND CORRECT MEMBERSHIP NUMBER on every letter. It is to your advantage to submit payment registration separately, and NOT TO add other payments to it, since SEPARATE exam payments do not get referred to other IPMZ departments.

2. Please **USE THE EXAMINATION REGISTRATION FORM** on the reverse of this page and **Complete ALL details.**

IMPORTANT DETAILS on the form need **ACCURACY.**

Membership Number This is used for the computer input so is vital if **YOU** want to be registered for the examination and **NOT** register someone else.

Subject On occasions, **IPMZ** staff have great difficulty in deciding which subject **YOU** want to write. Please give correct, full name of the subjects e.g.

not just “Training” but “Training Techniques” or “Management of Training.”

Venue **IPMZ** need to know where **YOU** wish to write – otherwise we have to allocate the nearest centre to your current address, and that may not be your preference, making double work for everyone and resulting in unnecessary delays.

3. **DEADLINE DATES ARE NOT NEGOTIABLE.**

The dates for examination registration for the October 2022 are between:

8.00 am Monday 1st August 2022 and 3.30 pm Friday 02 September 2022 when examination registration ends.

A few minutes late – for whatever reason – will mean a 6 months delay in writing your examination. Please plan ahead and submit your registration **IN GOOD TIME.**

4. Remember that

- **IF** your 2022 subscription is not paid, and
- **IF** you have not paid for, and received, study material for the subject you apply to write-

YOUR REGISTRATION WILL NOT BE PROCESSED, and you cannot write the examinations.

PLEASE NOTE THAT YOUR PAYMENT WILL BE FORFEITED.
